WINDSOR, CONN., November 4, 2025 – With the start of the holiday season just weeks away, a **longtime, community-minded Windsor Center business is again encouraging area residents to step up and come assist those in town who can use some help during these challenging times.**

On **Saturday, November 15th between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m.**, Windsor Ace Hardware at 296 Broad St. will host its **annual Fall fundraiser for the Windsor Food & Fuel Bank**, an event that also offers donors a shopping discount inside the store that same day. Anyone who comes and contributes at least \$5 gets a 5-gallon utility bucket, along with 20 percent off on almost anything in the store that fits in it.
