WEEKEND WHEELS STUDENT FOOD PROGRAM <u>REGISTRATION OPENS AUG. 1st FOR THE 2024/2025 School Year</u>

Weekend Wheels is a supplemental food program that provides qualifying Windsor children in grades **pre-k thru 12th grade** with a bag filled with food for the weekend. This program distributes during the school year – September thru June.

Our mission is to keep children nutritiously satisfied thru the weekend and ready to focus on school learning. This program distributes during the school year.

The distributions for this school year are currently in a weekly home delivery format and are brought directly to your doorstep.

Eligibility for the program is based on household income. If you qualify for free or reduced school meals you are automatically qualified for Weekend Wheels.

The table below shows a yearly gross income for each family size. If your household income is at or below the income listed for the number of people in your household, you are eligible to receive TEFAP commodities. (235% of poverty).
