



Sage Park CHARGER PACKS

Would it be beneficial for my family?

- Sage Park CHARGER PACKS, an extension of the Windsor Food and Fuel Bank Weekend Wheels program, is a supplemental weekend food program that provides a drawstring bag filled with food and snacks to students to bring home on Thursdays for the weekend. Drawstring bags are returned on Mondays to be repacked for the upcoming Thursday distribution. This program distributes Sage Park Middle School.
- Food provided in the bags help supplement food costs on weekends.
- Eligibility for the program is based on household income. See below. The table below shows a yearly gross income for each family size. If your household income is at or below the income listed for the number of people in your household, you are eligible to receive TEFAP commodities. (235% of poverty).

If you qualify for free or reduced school meals or are a client of the Windsor Food Bank, you are automatically qualified for a Charger Pack.

How do I register for this program?
